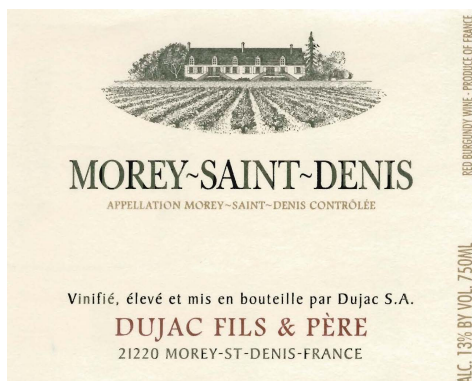

- Total Vineyards: 32.98 ha (81.5 acres) village vineyards.
- Winery Holdings: Purchased fruit – area (hectares) varies.
- Home to 5 Grand Cru vineyards, 20 Premier Cru Climats and 26 AOC Lieux-dits.
- Grand Cru vineyards grow only red grapes.
- Premier Cru and AOC vineyards grow both red and white grapes.
