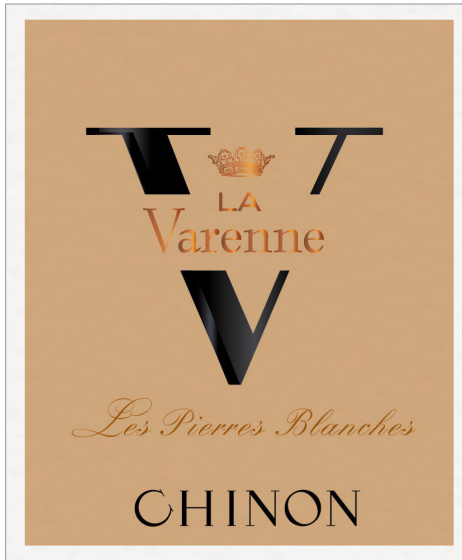

Laurent and Stéphane Gouron tend the 72 acre La Varenne estate which is surrounded by forests. All of their vineyards are located within the Appellation of Chinon.

Vineyard Profile

Made from 50 year old vines, naturally providing lower yields and more concentrated fruits, planted on predominantly gravelly soils, and rocky terraces.

- 30 Hectares – 4 hectares devoted to Les Pierres Blanches
- Aging in thermo-regulated stainless steel tanks
- Sustainable Agriculture Practices
- 50 year old vines – 40 to 45 hectares yield
