2019 Grüner Veltliner Ried Steinagrund

This is very steely with green apples and lightly spiced pears and lychees. Attractive fruit. Medium body and creamy texture. Turns lightly smoky at the end. Drink now. **91**

2019 Riesling Ried Schillingsberg

A serious riesling with mango, spice and slightly bitter citrus on the nose and palate. It's medium-to full-bodied with a lovely core of fruit and a delicious finish. Drink now. **92**

2019 Riesling Ried Brunthal Erste Lagen

Although this has plenty of peachy fruit and a fullish body, there's easily enough freshness and lively acidity to keep this crowd pleaser on track. A very appealing and food-friendly wine. Drink or hold. Screw cap. **92**

2018 Roter Veltliner Reid Scheiben

Lots of very ripe apricots with some toffee and a hint of bitter coffee. Sappy. It's full-bodied and lightly sweet with a thick, intense finish. Drink now. **91**

2019 Roter Veltliner Ried Fumberg

A dense white with toffee and apple-tart aromas and flavors. Full bodied, oily and firm at the end. Candied apple in the aftertaste. Drink or hold. **91**

2019 Grüner Veltliner Ried Scheiben Erste Lagen

A generous, ripe gruner with just enough acidity to keep it on track. Nice, creamy texture and crowd-pleasing, ripe pear and apple aromas. Drink now. **90**

2019 Grüner Veltliner Felser Klassik

Lots of licorice and aniseed character, as well as pear and citrus. Some green papaya. Medium to full body with lovely fruit and a fresh finish. Drink now. Screw cap. **91**

2019 Gruner Veltliner Ried Schafflerberg

Mango and papaya with some dried-lemon and slate character. It's medium-bodied and layered with lovely fruit on the finish. Licorice and mineral undertones. Drink now. Screw cap. **92**
