

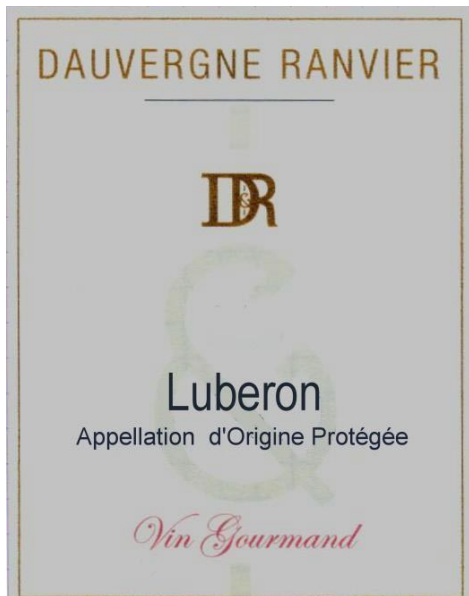

Vineyard Profile

- Size of vineyard (acres): 3.3
- Soil composition: Clay and limestone soils mostly.
- Training method: double cordon of Royat
- Vines/acre: 4500
- Yield/acre (tons): 40hl/ha
- Year vineyard planted: 1960

Harvest Notes

- 2013 is a particularly late vintage, suitable for fruity and structured wines. After a beautiful early summer, September was quite cold compared to the heat of the daytime. We worked with properties whose vines (2/3rd Syrah and 1/3rd Grenache) are located in the north appellation (Bonnieux and Coustellet) and the southern part (Lourmarin & Cucuron) on clay-stony soils located between 110 and 350 meters elevation.
- We vinified at low temperatures to magnify natural fruit flavors.
