## LANGHE NEBBIOLO - 2021

### RIZZI

Nestled at the very top of the impressively steep, vine-clad hills of the Treiso zone of Barbaresco, the winery's vineyards were planted as early as the 1960's in the white marl, calcareous soil typical of this area. An impressive selection of cru Barbaresci is punctuated by the spectacular Vigna Boito located at the peak of the Rizzi cru. The estate is managed entirely by the Dellapiana family with son Enrico as winemaker and viticulturist. Rizzi Winery participates in "The Green Experience" project which mandates guidelines for environmentally sustainable production.

### THE WINE

#### Vineyard Profile

Vineyards in Treiso.

- Altitude: 750-1210 feet/230-370 meters
- Exposure: South, Southwest
- Soil: White marl, clayey calcareous with alternate sandy layers
- Vines Planted: 1995 – 2015
- Vine Training System: Guyot

#### Harvest Notes

- Hand harvested into small crates the first 10 days of October
- Fermented in stainless steel tanks at controlled temperature <86°F for 3 weeks
- Racked, then malolactic fermentation for a month
- Aged 12 months in large Slavonian oak barrels

#### Winemaker's Notes

Langhe Nebbiolo is the perfect example of how to understand the king of Piedmontese vines and this wine is a classic yet contemporary version. Bright ruby in the glass, it releases fruity, floral and spicy aromas. The fine body and tannic structure are mouth-wateringly elegant.
