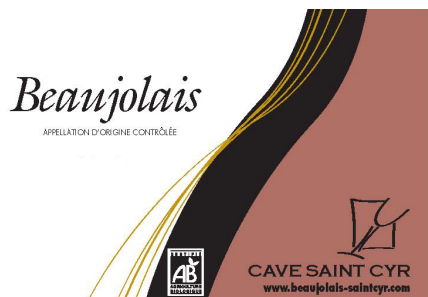


# Saint-Cyr

That was in 1980. Today the family winery is run by Thierry, his wife Laurence, son Raphael, and Raphael's wife, Karine. This family affair produces wines of purity and focus from the appellations of Beaujolais.
