DOMAINE DE MONTCY

Domaine de Montcy is an estate in the Loire Valley carefully tended by the three brothers of Chevrier family, Valérie, Thierry and Vincent. With an aim to produce wines at the highest level the Cheverny appellation has to offer, they farm about 30 hectares across four main plots in the communes of Cheverny, Cormeray, Chitenay and more recently Celettes. It is also one of the few producers of the tiny appellation of Cour-Cheverny. Vincent Bonnal brings his vineyard and cellar expertise to the domaine along with his acumen with natural wines. In 2020 the family constructed a new, eco-built cellar in Cormeray, heralding the future of Domaine de Montcy.

- Soil: Chalky-siliceous
- Vineyards Certified Organic by EcoCert since 2012, Certified Biodynamic by DEMETER since 2015

Harvest Notes

- Hand harvested
- Fermented in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks using only indigenous yeasts and without enzymes
- Minimal and controlled use of SO₂
- Aged 4 months in tank

Winemaker's Notes

An ode to the Loire and the liveliness of its constantly renewed waters. Pale yellow in the glass. Aromas of acacia flowers, classic Sauvignon Blanc and white fruits, with lilac notes developing. The palate is round and full of freshness. Complexity and elegance on the long finish capped with notes of pastry crust.

A friendly companion as an aperitif, pair with raw vegetables, grilled fish or goat cheeses.
