DOMAINE DE MONTCY

Domaine de Montcy is an estate in the Loire Valley carefully tended by the three brothers of Chevrier family, Valérie, Thierry and Vincent. With an aim to produce wines at the highest level the Cheverny appellation has to offer, they farm about 30 hectares across four main plots in the communes of Cheverny, Cormeray, Chitenay and more recently Celettes. It is also one of the few producers of the tiny appellation of Cour-Cheverny. Vincent Bonnal brings his vineyard and cellar expertise to the domaine along with his acumen with natural wines. In 2020 the family constructed a new, eco-built cellar in Cormeray, heralding the future of Domaine de Montcy.

Vineyard Profile

Estate vineyards in A.O.C. Cheverny.

- Soils: Clay on limestone
- Vine Training Systems: Cordon for Pinot Noir, Baguette for Gamay
- Vineyards certified Organic by EcoCert, certified Biodynamic by DEMETER

Harvest Notes

- Hand harvested
- Fermented in stainless steel tanks using only indigenous yeasts and without enzymes
- Minimal and controlled use of SO₂
- Aged in stainless steel tanks on fine lees for 4 months

Winemaker's Notes

"Cabriole" denotes a happy jump. First intense nose of red fruit and cherry. Spicy notes develop. Soft, velvety tannins wrap around the palate, leading to a long, soft finish. Elegance illustrates the sophistication of the Cheverny soils.

- 65% Pinot Noir, 35% Gamay with a touch of Cot (Malbec)
- Alcohol: 12.5%
