VINEYARDS

The winery has vineyards in the heart of Piedmont, in the Langhe region, and the main cellar is located in La Morra. Sustainable and organic farming practices are used in order to produce the highest quality grapes possible. In Valentina’s own words: “It is at the heart of our winemaking.”

The Marrone family farms with the least intervention possible from harvest to winemaking, resulting in elegant, structured wines that can be enjoyed at release, and will evolve for over a decade.
