VINEYARDS

Aromatic volume and fruit integrity is the Valenciso ideal. The organically farmed vineyards are established in chalky-clay soils at Rioja Alta's northwestern extreme.

WINEMAKING

Fermentation, malolactic fermentation and clarification take place naturally in modern, cement vats, and limited, judicious use of oak barrels.
